Applications for membership will be forwarded to the Technical Committee who will take up the references given to support your application.

Annual fee - £350 +VAT

Companies must agree to promote the BwfA where possible and aim to only employ BwfA accredited installers. It is essential that the end user (customer) is made aware of the importance of BwfA installers.

All applications to join the BwfA must be supported by references (permission must be granted by each referee listed for BWFA to contact them):

- For Companies involved in installation (installer, contractor, retailer, shop fitter, builder, carpenter etc) details of three customer references should be provided.
- For Suppliers (Companies that are not contracted to install wood flooring manufacturers, distributors, suppliers, architects etc) details of **two** trade references should be provided.

Applications for membership will be forwarded to the Technical Committee who will take up the references given to support your application.

The Board of Management's decision on applications is final.
